Myron came to Christ Child House in 1998 with then Executive Director, John Yablonky. Myron was a Youth Specialist, and moved into the Recreation Coordinator position. His responsibilities increased over time, and he also assumed the Education Coordinator role.

Over the past several years, Myron advanced to the position of Director of Health and Safety at Christ Child House. He was responsible for onboarding new personnel, CPR and CPI training, and most importantly, Myron maintained the safety of our children while at the house.

He lead staff training and life-skills training for the teenagers who called Christ Child House their home. He taught these boys how to manage money, how to wash clothes, how to wash a car, how to change a tire, how to apply for a job, how to tie a tie, and many other life skills that hundreds of people, now adults, can be happy that he took the time to teach them.

He loved his job, and he loved those kids.

Myron's ready smile, kindness and gentle approach when working with the boys will be remembered forever. His example is one that should never be forgotten.

Myron leaves behind three sons and a loving extended family. He was 55 years old.
